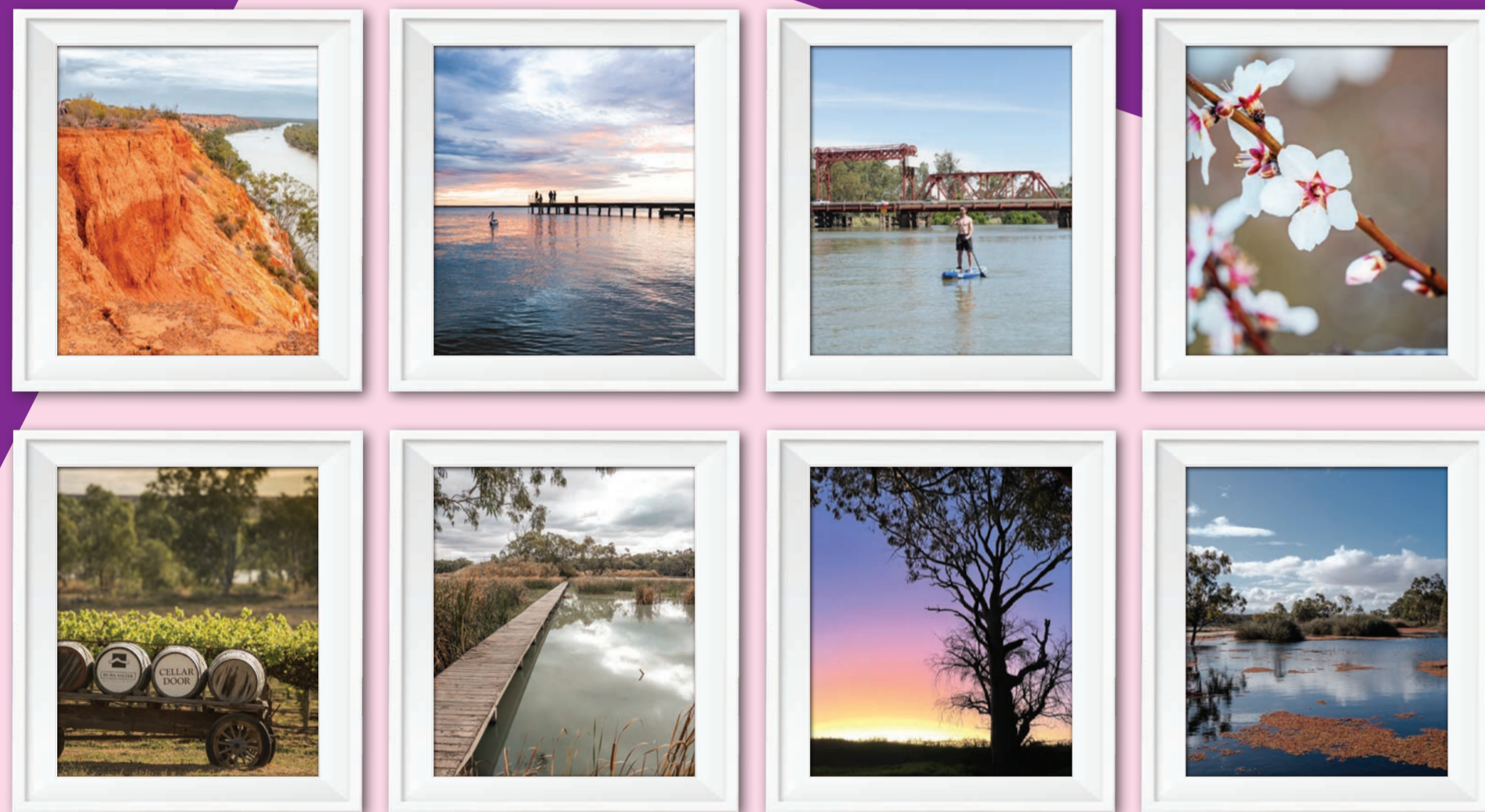
RIVERLAND BY THE LENS

BIRD WATCHING

Banrock Station Wetlands are home to an abundance of birds and wildlife. Take a walk around the Wetland Circuit and take advantage of their bird-watching "hides" for that perfect shot. After the 2022/2023 flood event the birds have proved to come out on top in enormous numbers.

BRIDGES

For scenic photo opportunities and history rolled into one, Paringa Bridge is a must. The famous red bridge can be snapped from the beautiful Bert Dix Park, Paringa. Blanchetown also boasts an impressive structure stretching over the majestic waterway, with expansive cliffs and Lock No 1 close by.

LOCKS

The Riverland is home to six locks situated along its 362 kilometre stretch of river. Make the most of your road trip by ticking them off along the way. Lock No 5 at Paringa boasts great photo opportunities, including The 'Bunyip' – an 80 ton barge, and the ever-popular Paringa Sandbar just up the road.

SUNSETS

The Riverland is renowned for its stunning backdrops, but add in a sunset or sunrise and your photo will be award-worthy. Choose a scene from the endless vineyards, Mallee scrublands, wetlands or the breathtaking Lake Bonney. Around every corner is a new photo break featuring the spectacular rainbow of colours our sunsets offer.

LOOKOUTS

Be sure to capture the setting sun from Heaven Lookout, Loxton, or the rising sun from Headings Cliff Lookout, Paringa. You will also find must-see views at the Waikerie Clifftop Walk, Berri Lookout Tower, or the Renmark Rotary Lookout Tower. Pick the right time of day to maximise those keepsake photos.

BACKWATERS AND CREEKS

Katarapko Creek, Bookpurnong, Loch Luna and Moorook Game Reserve, Kingston-On-Murray, and Ral Ral Creek, branching into the infamous Dinghy Derby track, Renmark. Whether it's via foot, bike, boat or canoe, you will be sure to capture the most mesmerising and special moments across the Riverland's flowing waterways.

HISTORY TIME

Immerse yourself in the unique history of the Riverland, with the region's heritage dating back to the First Peoples of the River Murray and Mallee.

From the geological marvels of ancient lands, to the colonial history of steamboats working the waters, and wartime tales, there is a wealth of antiquity in the region and many history buffs to learn from. Around every river bend, there are untapped stories waiting to be told.

Historian delights can be found in multiple Riverland towns, with the

Waikerie Pioneer Museum, Loxton Historical Village, and Olivewood Historic Homestead and Museum just a select few to be found along the way.

Most towns are also home to historic buildings and hotels with unique architecture, and while though some have undergone renovations in recent years, they still hold the charm of their history in the walls.

Set sail on a piece of history on a paddle steamer, like the Industry in Renmark, and learn how the river thrived with paddle steamers from the 1860s to the early 1900s, transporting passengers and goods throughout the region.

FERRIES

Take a short trip from one side of the Murray to the other on one of the iconic ferries dotting along our river.

Today, the remaining ferries make part of the local transport network in the Riverland, with their importance highlighted even more when they were shut down in the flood event of 2022/23. These modern, cable ferries operate 24 hours and are free to use. Ferry crossings can be found at Lyrup, Waikerie, Cadell and Morgan with each vessel named after a native bird species.

LOCKS AND WEIRS

In the 1920s, a series of locks and weirs were installed along the River Murray, used to divert water to the emerging agriculture industry. These also help to improve the navigation of boats along the river.

There are six locks in the Riverland between Blanchetown (Lock 1) and Murtho (Lock 6). You can read up on the interpretative information at the locks, plus explanations at the barge, Bunyip, located at Lock 5, which explains how the locks were built and how they are operated. Locks 2, 4 and 5 also have free barbecue and picnic areas, and, if you're lucky, you may even see a boat pass through the lock chamber.

WAR TIME

The Riverland played an important part in the wartime history of South Australia, with significant links to local industries, soldier migration and family ancestry today.

Solider settlement schemes were established during both World Wars in the region to repatriate and compensate returning servicemen and their families. These schemes offered farming land to returned soldiers and were integral to the growth of many Riverland towns, stamping a long-lasting legacy on local agriculture, innovation, culture and resilience. Many of the wine grape vines from soldier settlement still stand and are used to produce unique wines.

A self-guided driving tour, following the Loxton Street Memorials website, presents the origins and unique names of the district's streets. Named after every Australian Victoria Cross recipient post World War I, every South Australian

Military Nurse who died in service during World War II, and the battlegrounds where Australians have fought, the area's roads form a comprehensive honour roll.

Marvel at Olivewood Historic Homestead and Museum, which was the Riverland home of Charles Chaffey, and today serves as a museum of local history including pioneers and the development of early irrigation systems.

With a focus on early irrigation, steam-powered engineering principles. In particular, the Humphrey pump, the Cobdogla Irrigation and the Steam Museum is a must visit for every history buff.

In Waikerie, learn from storyboards depicting early irrigation at Federation Park, or see the decommissioned Worthington steam engine at Pioneer Park. Loxton has a similar series of information through the median strip on East Terrace. Relics of historic irrigation are found scattered throughout the region with decommissioned pumps on show in many Riverland towns.



Loveday Internment Collection

Housed at the Barmera Visitor Information Centre, this permanent display tells the stories of the foreign nationals who were held at the Loveday Internment Camp during the Second World War. Multi-media displays show why the camp was built and how internees lived and worked during their incarceration. Free admission, open 9am to 4pm weekdays, 10am to 1pm weekends.

2,000 People Attend At Memorial Oval

Berri, Aug. 21
 Following on the announcement by the Prime Minister that Japan had accepted the Allied surrender terms, gay scenes were witnessed in the streets of Berri. Many people were already at their places of employment, but as soon as they realized that this time the news was official, all shops and business establishments immediately closed down. Motor car horns were tooted, bells rang, the Fire Brigade siren sounded out in a wailing, weeping scream, and above all the whistle from the irrigation pumps could be heard all over the area. Land Army girls stopped work at Toora Vale and dashed into the town on two crowded motor lorries whooping, yelling and singing all types of songs. Flags, bunting and crackers appeared from all directions.

Distances Between towns (km)



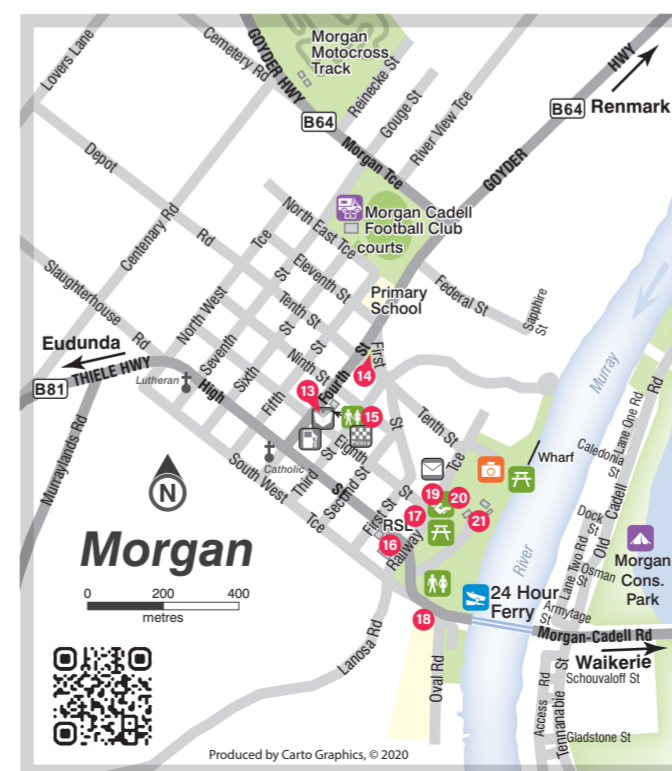

BERRI

A SPECIAL PLACE FOR JIMMY JAMES

Riverview Drive
Artists Stephen Fox and Bluey Roberts designed this commemoration of Jimmy James II, a famous Aboriginal tracker. The finely polished granite slab is framed with engravings of Murray River birds and animals, which were very much part of Jimmy's spirit world.

BERRI BRIDGE MURAL

(Under Berri Bridge, road access via Crawford Terrace or walking access via Riverview Drive)

This piece depicts the Ngarrindjeri dreamtime story of the origins of the Murray River. The work was designed by artist Garry Duncan and developed with local indigenous artists Gladys Elsie Sumner, Shane Karpany, Jason Karpany and Ikey Lindsay.

HOPE STREET MURAL

Vaughan Terrace median strip
The Hope Street project saw a number of murals developed on commercial buildings in South Australian regional towns. Completed in 2018, Berri's mural signifies the positive relationship between art and mental health and was painted by Adelaide artist, Sarah Boese.

BERRI PLANTER BOXES

As you're walking through Berri's CBD, keep an eye out for these unique canvases. Each of the eight planter boxes displays original artwork by Riverland artists.



BARMERA

BARMERA BUS TERMINAL ARTWORK

Barmera Visitor Information Centre
Artist Anthony Leske enlivened the entrance to the town by depicting fishing from the jetty, silhouetted against the iconic Lake Bonney sunset.

BARMERA PERMANENT PROJECTION SITE

The iconic Bonney Theatre lights up on selected nights through the magic of digital projection. For information on the latest light show and times enquire at the Barmera Visitor Centre, or check out the Berri Barmera Council website.

BARMERA THEATRE GALLERY

This shop front is an integral part of the art-deco style Bonney Theatre, centrally located on Barmera's main street. Barmera Theatre Gallery has a wide variety of art and craftworks for sale, produced by a diverse group of artists and artisans aged from 20 to 90 years.

BLUEBIRD SCULPTURE

Dean Drive, opposite playspace
A representation of Donald Campbell's famous boat Bluebird, which set an Australian water speed record on Lake Bonney in 1964.

CELEBRATION OF LIFE

Barwell Avenue median strip
Local artist Mark Chiles created and donated this bronze sculpture to the town of Barmera, to represent life of the town.

MORGAN

WINDOWS OF TIME

Take a step back in time and marvel at the stunning mural on display at the Morgan Landseer Museum.

LOXTON

TREE SCULPTURES

Bookpurnong Terrace
At the entrance to the town's Community Conservation and Heritage Park stand 16 sculptures depicting native flora and fauna carved by local artist Tim Balderstone from lopped Aleppo Pines.

COUNTERBALANCE AND AVRO ANSON

Corner of Bookpurnong Terrace & Mill Road
Commissioned to acknowledge Loxton's Centenary of Proclamation in 2007, each of the sculptures' 10 glass plates represent each decade. The nearby replica Avro Anson aircraft display was crafted by local community members Josh and Abe McIntosh.

EAST TERRACE

The community's farming history has been reflected in various pieces of public art within the town centre, from rustic art scenes in alleyways, to large Loxton signs at the entry to East Terrace and at the town wharf.

LOXTON TOWN FOUNTAIN

Loxton Library & Visitor Centre
Six copper plaques feature in the fountain's design, hand crafted by local copper sculptor Vern Wilksch, and depict the heritage and history of Loxton. Erected in 1991 and funded by local residents John and Ruth Moore.

LOXTON RSL

Corner of Tobruk Terrace & Anzac Crescent
Standing at rest at the front of the building is a digger, carved from a pine tree that once stood at this site. It was carved by local artist Tim Baulderstone. A mural depicting various scenes of war adorns the front of the building and metal aircraft silhouettes on the west side are back-lit at night.

RENMARK

HOPE STREET MURAL

James Avenue
This contemporary, collaborative community mural was painted by the talented Jack Fran as part of the Hope Street project. Jack also painted the Smokehouse mural located in Leslie Lane adjacent to the ABS Smokehouse Pizza Café.

DAVID RUSTON SCULPTURE

James Avenue, Jarret Memorial Gardens
Janette Moore was commissioned to create this artwork in recognition of David Ruston who made a global contribution to floriculture, in particular the rose. A bronze figure shows David engulfed in flowers and in his typical pose with secateurs upside down as he used them.

HARRY CLARK FOUNTAIN

Murray Avenue
Originally designed by Peter Everingham, the fountain has been repurposed to create an interactive water feature in the new Taylor Riverfront Precinct.

SHI SHI LION STATUE

Murray Avenue
This friendship gift from the Chinese City of Shi Shi to the residents of Renmark Paringa District was unveiled in 2000.

PARINGA

PARINGA SILO ART

Sturt Highway, Paringa
Painted by renowned artist Jack Fran the Paringa Silo's feature four distinct images - two on the front facing the Sturt Highway and two on the rear of the structure - linked together with soaring pelicans. Local characters were selected to feature as the base silhouettes, with the story of the district told through the images within the profiles.

WAIKERIE

STRANGMAN TESTIMONIAL BANNER

Waikerie Library & Visitor Centre
Gifted to C.L Strangman by the Chinese community of Darwin, this banner is over 100 years old and embroidered in majestic gold.

PADDLE STEAMER TO THE TABLE

White Street
Reclaimed using old wood from a jetty, this sculpture was built by local artist Garry Duncan in recognition of AH Landseer, the first store owner.

RAIN MOTH MOSAICS

4 Peake Terrace
Surrounding the Rain Moth Gallery, there are a number of mosaic projects created in collaboration with Waikerie students. The works include The Wave Mosaic Seat, Flight of The Rain Moth and The Locals.

WAIKERIE SILO ART

Ian Oliver Drive
Take a selfie at Waikerie's silos, where two artists, local Garry Duncan, and Melbourne street artist, Jimmy Dvate have painted the original silos in native flora and fauna, titled 'Healthy River Healthy Community'.

'WEI KARI' SCULPTURES

Marking the entrance to the Waikerie riverfront, these metal sculptures depict the 'Wei Kari', the name given by the Ngawait people for the Giant Swift Moth found in the area, also known as the Rain Moth.

LIFE CYCLES OF A RAIN MOTH

4 McCoy Street
This 30-metre long mural shows different stages of the lifecycle of the Rain Moth. Viewers will be amazed at the intricate detail and 3D effect of this work of art by artist Jimmy Dvate.

WAIKERIE

PADDLE STEAMER ART

3 Peake Terrace
Created by Waikerie artist Susan Skujins, this mural depicts two important vessels in Waikerie's early history, the PS Waikerie and PS Etona.

CRUSTA CUP TROPHY

Waikerie Library & Visitor Centre
Wooden sculpture created by artist Greg Duncan for the 'Crusta Cup' community event featuring carvings of prominent river species.

'ANGEL WINGS'

4 White Street
On the side of the Waikerie post office building, the wall is awash with wings by Riverland artist Jacqui Mason.

RIVERGLEN VIEW ART STUDIO & GALLERY

With artworks as stunning as the views, this unique and private river-front gallery features original kiln-fired glass artworks, canvas paintings and prints by local artists, Clint and Liz Frankel.

MURRAY COD ART

Peake Terrace & Rowe Street
Artist Jimmy Dvate created this lifelike tribute to the Murray cod, one of the largest native freshwater species in Australia and a feature of our river ecosystem.

Riverland Artist Hub was formed by a group of Riverland Artists over 10 years ago. PORT OF MORGAN'S RIVERFRONT PRECINCT

Morgan is home to a picturesque riverfront with plenty to see and do. It's the perfect spot for a picnic with family or a lazy afternoon. A must see for families is the Morgan Rail to River Playground with free barbecue facilities and an amazing paddle steamer for the children to enjoy.

PADDLE STEAMER CANALLY, MORGAN WHARF

PS Canally is a side wheel paddle steamer that was originally launched in 1907. local group of volunteers work tirelessly to restore this beautiful and historic vessel. If paddle steamers tickle your fancy then this one is well worth a look.

LANDSEER MUSEUM, MORGAN

Step back in time and visit the Landseers Museum, you'll find a collection of artefacts and mementos from this era, telling the story of local rail and river trade history. Come see the new 'Windows of Time' mural consisting of five panels of magnificent artwork done by three local ladies. Each panel tells 30 years in Morgan's history.

CADELL'S GRAHAM CLAXTON RESERVE

Get back into nature by visiting this river-side reserve. With beautiful river views and a fantastic location for camping, this spot is well and truly a hidden gem for nature lovers. While you're there pop over and enjoy Cadell's Malcolm Moss walking trail - located left of Graeme Claxton Reserve. A must see for those that like the outdoors and enjoy the beautiful bird life.

LOCK 1 AT BLANCHETOWN

Lock 1 has been assisting river travel since 1922. It was the first of the series of locks and weirs that provided year-round navigability for river boats below the junction of the Murray and Darling rivers.

OLD WHARF SOUVENIR AND CRAFT SHOP

Located on the Morgan riverfront near the Station Masters House, this shop was the old ticket office for the trains. It has since been converted into a souvenir and gift shop, showcasing local produce and homemade goods from members of the community.



ADVENTURE & OUTDOORS

The Riverland is a treasure trove of activities and escapades for the outdoor adventurer. With stunning scenery, walking trails, landmarks and wildlife, there's plenty to discover around every turn.

Visitors can hire speed boats (complete with all ski equipment), jet skis, stand-

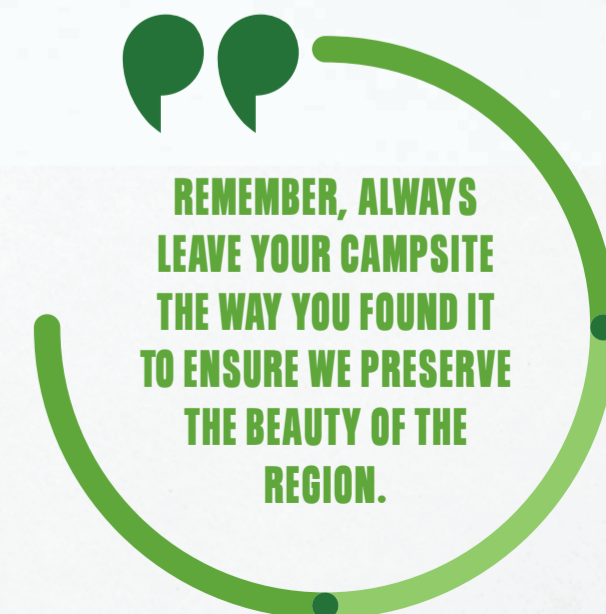
up paddleboards, kayaks and canoes - making water sports easily accessible to those without their own equipment.

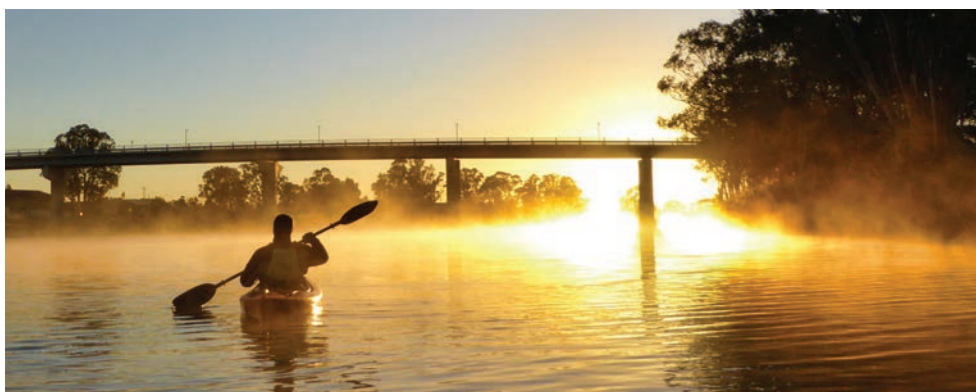

NATURE TIME

The region boasts a diverse range of natural landscapes, including wetlands, national parks and conservation areas, and towering cliffs. These settings provide a picturesque backdrop for outdoor activities such as hiking, birdwatching, and water sports.

Protected spaces provide opportunities for bushwalking, camping, and experiencing the native flora and fauna. Local knowledge is often the key to finding the hidden gems, so ask a local or a staff member at one of the region's Visitor Information Centres before you head off, or consider joining an organised tour.

For those keen to lace up their hiking boots, there are a number of designated walks – along the river, around wetlands and

further afield. Wetland walks at places like Calperum Station near Renmark and Banrock Station by Kingston-on-Murray showcase the diversity of native flora and fauna and highlight the critical role that water plays in sustaining these ecosystems.

Local national parks also include walking trails, with free entry for daily visits. If you're keen on a longer stay, you can camp at several sites – book online through the national parks website to secure your camping spot.

Amazing riverside camping locations are also available to book and explore, however many were inundated in the 2022/23 flood event and may be closed to public access while maintenance is ongoing.

Remember, always leave your campsite the way you found it to ensure we preserve the beauty of the region.

MUST SEE AND DO:

LOXTON HISTORICAL VILLAGE

From East Terrace it is a short stroll to the Loxton Historical Village. The region's open-air museum features more than 45 buildings, plus numerous farming equipment displays, giving visitors a taste of what life was like for the region's pioneers. The Loxton Historical Village is featured in the Loxton History Tour podcast, which can be accessed via the Storytowns App.

THE PINES HISTORIC HOUSE AND GARDEN

This historic home, its contents and the extensive gardens were bequeathed to the people of Loxton by the late Ella Kingdon.

LOXTON PIONEER PLAYGROUND

For the young and young-at-heart, a stop off at the Loxton Pioneer Playground is a must-do. An ideal place for a picnic or barbecue under one of the sheltered seating areas, the playground features a large climbing structure, double flying fox, electronic NEOS game, and a bike/scooter track among many other things.

'HEAVEN' CLIFFTOP LOOKOUT

The 'Heaven' clifftop lookout – as it is affectionately referred to by locals – provides a vantage point above Habel's Bend to look out across the river to Katarapko Island, part of the Murray River National Park. Climb the 'stairway to Heaven' from the base of the cliff at Habel's Bend.

BANROCK STATION

While in the area you can also wander Banrock Station's boardwalks and trails that weave through the Ramsar listed wetland, which is home to more than 17,000 species of native plants, animals and birds.



BLUE BOAT

MUST SEE AND DO:

GLUEPOT RESERVE

Just 64km north of Waikerie is Gluepot Reserve, dedicated to the conservation of native bird species. Gluepot houses approximately 190 species of birds, 50 species of reptiles and 11 species of bats. Facilities for human visitors include a guest centre, campgrounds, bird hides, driving, walking and cycling trails.

WAIKERIE RIVERFRONT

With more than a kilometre of riverfront access there's plenty of shady trees, extensive grassed areas including an amphitheatre, picnic shelters, free barbecues, boat ramps, walking paths, toilets and ample parking. This is an excellent location for outdoor gatherings at any time of year with substantial river access for boating, fishing and swimming. The young (and young at heart) will have plenty to do with an undercover playground, pump track, sensory track and outdoor ping pong table.

CLIFFTOP WALK AND SILO ART

The Rotary Clifftop Walk stretches eastward from the Waikerie riverfront and ferry through the pumping station grounds, lookout tower and along the picturesque clifftop. Multiple vantage points provide spectacular views, especially for photographers, and there is plenty to see along the walk. A contemplation seat – donated by Silent Ripples – is waiting for those who wish to take a break, with a mini silo painted by Riverland artist Jarrod Loxton, a peace pole, and metal sculptures of various sizes. Picnic shelters are dispersed along the walk and water fountains are available for both people and dogs. The Clifftop Walk incorporates the Waikerie silo art. This must-see attraction is titled Healthy River, Healthy Community, featuring a giant yabby, regent parrot and semi-abstract river landscapes. The silo garden is complete with native plants and metal sculptures that include 'Murray', who visitors can take a selfie with and capture the beautifully painted silos in the background. The area from Cliff Street to the Waikerie silos is accessible to pushers and mobility aids.

WAIKERIE ART TRAIL

Waikerie showcases a diverse range of public art and galleries. Numerous buildings display creative, vibrant images of art significant to the area and two galleries are available to view local works of art. Drop into the Waikerie Library & Visitor Centre to pick up a trail map.



TRAVELLER'S GUIDE

A large majority of visitors to the Riverland travel by car – be it behind the steering wheel or in the coveted front seat and controlling the music – but it's not the only way to get here.

Public transport is limited, but it is available, and travels from Adelaide to the region's major towns and back, if required.

Having so much to explore away from the main thoroughfares of the towns, there are benefits of going about your adventuring in your own vehicle. If you don't have a car, ask a local Visitor

Information Centre to help plan your days to suit local bus timetables, or to put you in touch with car rental operators.

For those having a night out, a fleet of licensed taxis and small buses – which can be booked in advance – are at your disposal, but be aware of cut-off times. With award-winning hotels and clubs, and good old country pubs in every town, you won't need to travel too far for a drink or three.

If you're lucky enough to be touring the region on the mighty Murray, public moorings for houseboats and small vessels are available along the riverfronts so you can re-stock on supplies, dine or shop.

INFORMATION TIME

The Riverland has six Visitor Information Centres spread throughout the region in most major towns, and should be your first port of call for advice on navigating the local area. Look for the blue and yellow icon to find friendly staff who live in the community and have excellent knowledge of the local districts and beyond, who can tailor your time to suit your interests. Open seven days, including most public holidays, Visitor Information Centres are also hubs for local produce and souvenirs, so stop in and see what's on offer.

TIME FOR HELP?

Country hospitality and friendly support is found throughout the region, so if your holiday goes awry – even the best-planned trips do – just ask for help! Don't let the small-town appearances fool you, some of the most well-regarded professionals and services are available in the Riverland. Whether you're looking for a mechanic, a healthcare provider, an emergency vet, or even a hairdresser – some of the best are right here.
