Wind around locks and backwaters in Paringa Paddock or get the heart beat thumping at the Loxton Mountain Bike Track.

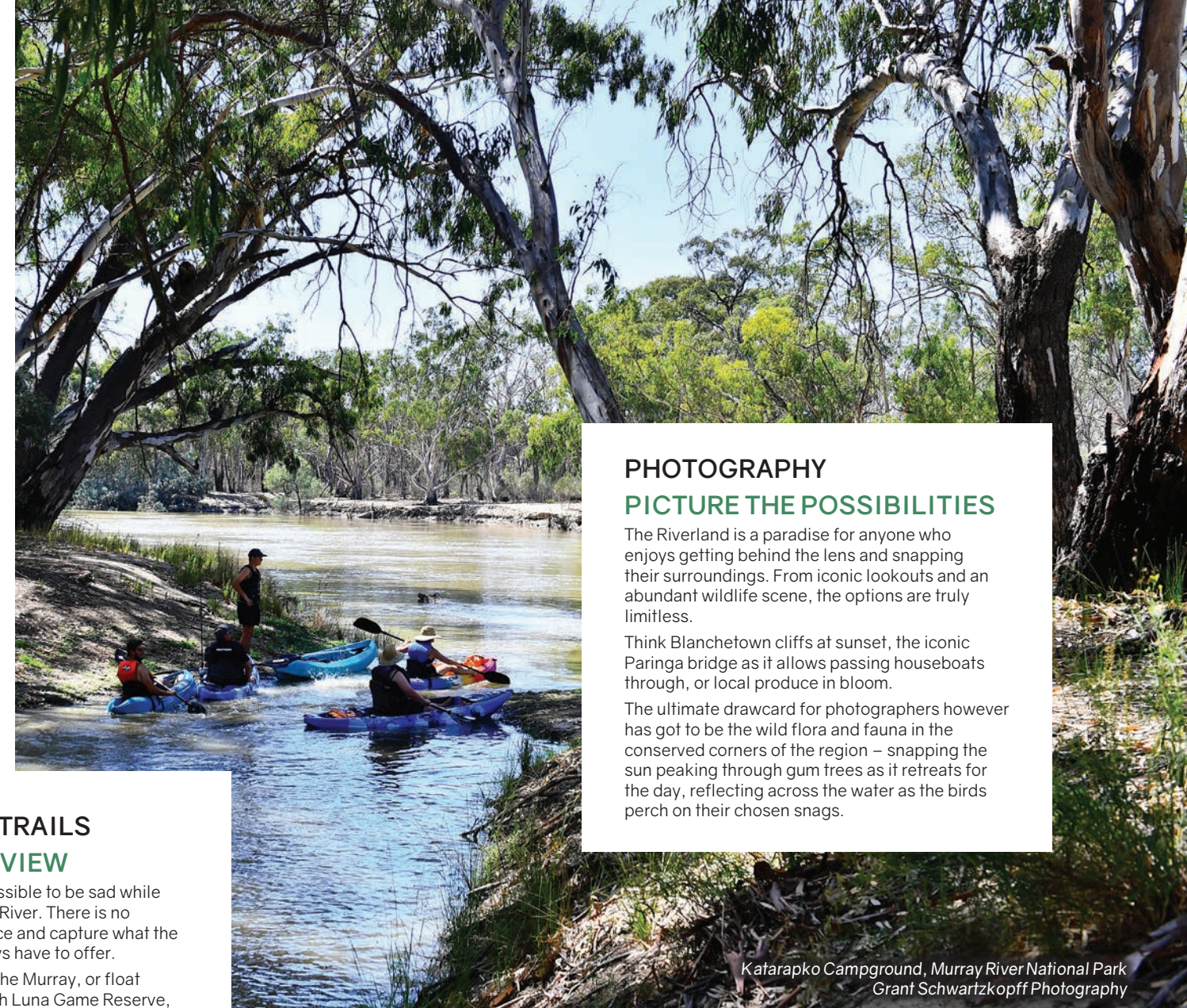
Pushed for time or looking for the slower pace? A leisurely stroll or roll along the town riverfronts will ease the mind and body.

The Riverland is a paradise for anyone who enjoys getting behind the lens and snapping their surroundings. From iconic lookouts and an abundant wildlife scene, the options are truly limitless.

Think Blanchetown cliffs at sunset, the iconic Paringa bridge as it allows passing houseboats through, or local produce in bloom.

WHATEVER THE VESSEL

The Riverland's largest drawcard, the Murray River, is not only Australia's largest river, it also brings with it a vast network of intertwining creeks, lakes, wetlands and floodplains. The region is not only home to the Riverland Dinghy Derby, but it also hosts an array of other sporting events.

Lake Bonney, in Barmera, hosts multiple yacht championship events across the calendar, while all major towns take pride in their rowing clubs. Renmark plays host to the 36km wharf to Woolshed Long Row - which anyone can enter as well as taking turns in hosting the largest state-wide rowing regatta every year, alternating with Berri every second year.

BERRI**A SPECIAL PLACE FOR JIMMY JAMES**
Riverview Drive

Artists Stephen Fox and Bluey Roberts designed this commemoration of Jimmy James II, a famous Aboriginal tracker. The finely polished granite slab is framed with engravings of Murray River birds and animals, which were very much part of Jimmy's spirit world.

BERRI BRIDGE MURAL
(Under Berri Bridge, road access via Crawford Terrace or walking access via Riverview Drive)
This piece depicts the Ngarrindjeri dreamtime story of the origins of the Murray River. The work was designed by artist Garry Duncan and developed with local indigenous artists Gladys Elsie Summer, Shane Karpany, Jason Karpany and Ikey Lindsay.

HOPE STREET MURAL
Vaughan Terrace median strip
The Hope Street project saw a number of murals developed on commercial buildings in South Australian regional towns. Completed in 2018, Berri's mural signifies the positive relationship between art and mental health and was painted by Adelaide artist, Sarah Boese.

BERRI PLANTER BOXES
As you're walking through Berri's CBD, keep an eye out for these unique canvases. Each of the eight planter boxes displays original artwork by Riverland artists.

BARMERA

BARMERA BUS TERMINAL ARTWORK
Barmera Visitor Information Centre
Artist Anthony Leske enlivened the entrance to the town by depicting fishing from the jetty, silhouetted against the iconic Lake Bonney sunset.

BARMERA PERMANENT PROJECTION SITE
The iconic Bonney Theatre lights up on selected nights through the magic of digital projection. For information on the latest light show and times enquire at the Barmera Visitor Centre, or check out the Berri Barmera Council website.

BARMERA THEATRE GALLERY
This shop front is an integral part of the art-deco style Bonney Theatre, centrally located on Barmera's main street. Barmera Theatre Gallery has a wide variety of art and craftworks for sale, produced by a diverse group of artists and artisans aged from 20 to 90 years.

BLUEBIRD SCULPTURE
Dean Drive, opposite playspace
A representation of Donald Campbell's famous boat Bluebird, which set an Australian water speed record on Lake Bonney in 1964.

CELEBRATION OF LIFE
Barwell Avenue median strip
Local artist Mark Chiles created and donated this bronze sculpture to the town of Barmera, to represent life of the town.

MORGAN

WINDOWS OF TIME
Take a step back in time and marvel at the stunning mural on display at the Morgan Landseer Museum.

LOXTON

MURALS
There are numerous murals around the township including the bright impactful façade of The Collective in East Terrace—painted by Scott Rathman and Jarrod Loxton. Other examples of Jarrod's work can be seen on the side of The Rusty Spoon café on Anzac Crescent and on the large wall of Seaman Chiropractic on Drabsch Street where he teamed up with Shane Karpany to tell the story of the blue wren Waatji pulyeri. Further down Drabsch Street you can also see the Loxcare mural featuring the talents of Lyn Anstey, the Loxton Art Group and community.

TREE SCULPTURES
Bookpurnong Terrace
At the entrance to the town's Community Conservation and Heritage Park stand 16 sculptures depicting native flora and fauna carved by local artist Tim Balderstone from lopped Aleppo Pines.

COUNTERBALANCE AND AVRO ANSON
Corner of Bookpurnong Terrace & Mill Road
Commissioned to acknowledge Loxton's Centenary of Proclamation in 2007, each of the sculptures' 10 glass plates represent each decade. The nearby replica Avro Anson aircraft display was crafted by local community members Josh and Abe McIntosh.

EAST TERRACE
The community's farming history has been reflected in various pieces of public art within the town centre, from rustic art scenes in alleyways, to large Loxton signs at the entry to East Terrace and at the town wharf. A set of ceramic tile scenes surrounding the town rotunda, designed by Stephen Bowers, depict the Riverland industries and environment.

LOXTON TOWN FOUNTAIN
Loxton Library & Visitor Centre
Six copper plaques feature in the fountain's design, hand crafted by local copper sculptor Vern Wilksch, and depict the heritage and history of Loxton. Erected in 1991 and funded by local residents John and Ruth Moore.

LOXTON RSL
Corner of Tobruk Terrace & Anzac Crescent
Standing at rest at the front of the building is a digger, carved from a pine tree that once stood at this site. It was carved by local artist Tim Balderstone. A mural depicting various scenes of war adorns the front of the building and metal aircraft silhouettes on the west side are back-lit at night.

MINI SILO ART TRAIL
Bookpurnong Terrace
Set within the Loxton Community and Conservation Park, this walking trail features local birdlife and animals painted on concrete pipe mini silo installations by local artist Jarrod Loxton.

RENMARK

HOPE STREET MURAL
James Avenue
This contemporary, collaborative community mural was painted by the talented Jack Fran as part of the Hope Street project. Jack also painted the Smokehouse mural located in Leslie Lane behind Yate's Menswear.

RENMARK cont.

DAVID RUSTON SCULPTURE
James Avenue, Jarret Memorial Gardens
Janette Moore was commissioned to create this artwork in recognition of David Ruston who made a global contribution to floriculture, in particular the rose. A bronze figure shows David engulfed in flowers and in his typical pose with secateurs upside down as he used them.

HARRY CLARK FOUNTAIN
Murray Avenue
Originally designed by Peter Everingham, the fountain has been repurposed to create an interactive water feature in the new Taylor Riverfront Precinct.

SHI SHI LION STATUE
Murray Avenue
This friendship gift from the Chinese City of Shi Shi to the residents of Renmark Paringa District was unveiled in 2000.

PARINGA

PARINGA SILO ART
Sturt Highway, Paringa
Painted by renowned artist Jack Fran the Paringa Silo's feature four distinct images - two on the front facing the Sturt Highway and two on the rear of the structure - linked together with soaring pelicans. Local characters were selected to feature as the base silhouettes, with the story of the district told through the images within the profiles.

WAIKERIE

STRANGMAN TESTIMONIAL BANNER
Waikerie Library & Visitor Centre
Gifted to C.L. Strangman by the Chinese community of Darwin, this banner is over 100 years old and embroidered in majestic gold.

PADDLE STEAMER TO THE TABLE
White Street
Reclaimed using old wood from a jetty, this sculpture was built by local artist Garry Duncan in recognition of AH Landseer, the first store owner.

RAIN MOTH MOSAICS
4 Peake Terrace
Surrounding the Rain Moth Gallery, there are a number of mosaic projects created in collaboration with Waikerie students. The works include The Wave Mosaic Seat, Flight of The Rain Moth and The Locals.

WAIKERIE SILO ART
Ian Oliver Drive
Take a selfie with local celebrity "Murray" at the Waikerie Silo Art where two artists, local Garry Duncan, and Melbourne street artist, Jimmy Dvate have painted the original silos in native flora and fauna, titled 'Healthy River Healthy Community'.

'WEI KARI' SCULPTURES
Marking the entrance to the Waikerie riverfront, these metal sculptures depict the 'Wei Kari', the name given by the Ngawait people for the Giant Swift Moth found in the area, also known as the rain moth.

LIFE CYCLES OF A RAIN MOTH
4 McCoy Street
This 30-metre long mural shows different stages of the lifecycle of the rain moth. Viewers will be amazed at the intricate detail and 3D effect of this work of art by artist Jimmy Dvate.

PADDLE STEAMER ART
3 Peake Terrace
Created by Waikerie artist Susan Skujins, this mural depicts two important vessels in Waikerie's early history, the PS Waikerie and PS Etona.

CRUSTA CUP TROPHY
Waikerie Library & Visitor Centre
Wooden sculpture created by artist Greg Duncan for the 'Crusta Cup' community event featuring carvings of prominent river species.

'ANGEL WINGS'
4 White Street
On the side of the Waikerie post office building, the wall is awash with wings by Riverland artist Jacqui Mason.

RIVERGLEN VIEW ART STUDIO & GALLERY
Good Hope Landing
With artworks as stunning as the views, this unique and private river-front gallery features original kiln-fired glass artworks, canvas paintings and prints by local artists, Clint and Liz Frankel. By appointment.

MURRAY COD ART
Peake Terrace & Rowe Street
Artist Jimmy Dvate created this lifelike tribute to the Murray cod, one of the largest native freshwater species in Australia and a feature of our river ecosystem.

VOLUNTEERS MURAL
O'Loughlin Street
This collage of Waikerie icons is dedicated to all past and present volunteers in the Waikerie community. Designed and painted by Riverland artist Jarrod Loxton.

KOOKABURRA MURAL
Clifftop Art Trail off Anells Street, Waikerie
Incorporated into the Clifftop Walk Art Trail is a mural featuring two kookaburras. They celebrate the birdlife that give Waikerie its name and the irrigation that allowed it to survive and prosper. This mural was painted by local artist Jarrod Loxton onto a disused concrete irrigation pipe.

CLIFFTOP ART TRAIL
Behind Silo Art, Ian Oliver Drive, Waikerie.
Meander through the art trail along the Rotary Clifftop Walk. Look for the metal sculptures of pelicans keeping a watchful eye, possums posing for an opportune photo, a loyal friend on a walk and a fellow sightseer. The area features a native garden and the Rotary Peace Pole, the 64th Peace Pole erected in Waikerie as a silent vigil and reminder of the need for peace in the world. There is a surprise around every corner.

OUTDOOR PING PONG TABLE
Water & Nature Play Park, Waikerie
Looking to add a little friendly competition to your holiday? Enjoy a fun game of ping-pong at the Waikerie Riverfront reserve surrounded by beautiful trees and parklands. Featuring citrus, flying swans and yabbies, this was painted by local artists Liz and Clint Frankel. Bats and balls supplied.

SCENIC FRAME
Ferry end of the Riverfront, Waikerie
Snap a photo of the Murray River inside this scenic frame at the riverfront. And if you time it right, include the iconic Waikerie ferry.

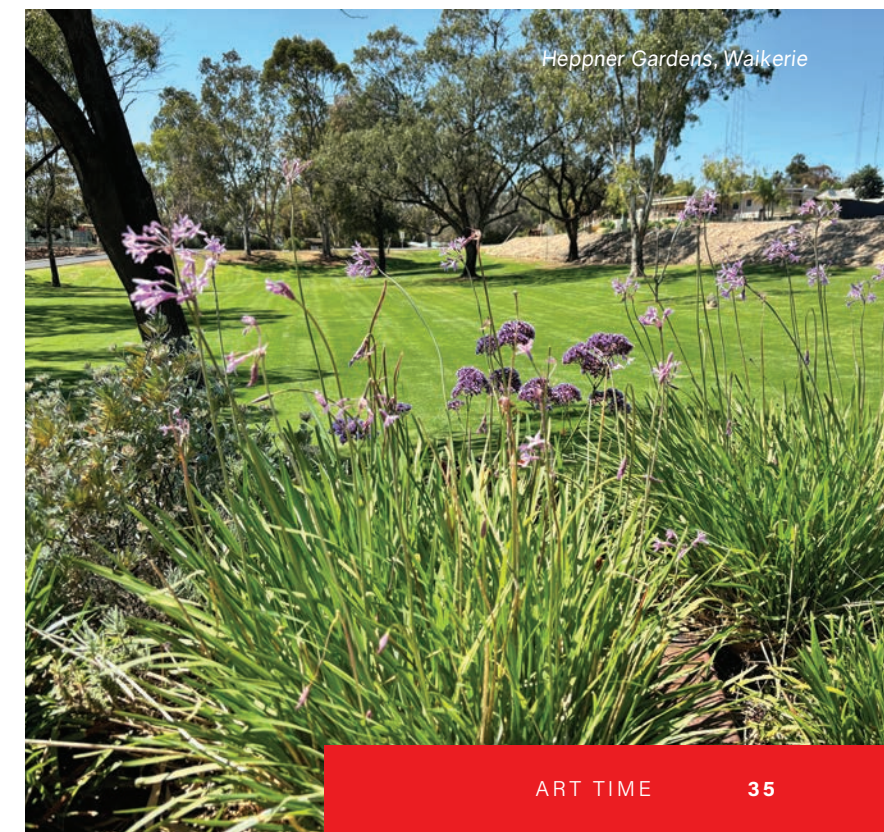

HISTORY TIME

Riverland towns proudly boast a number of historical attractions that provide a view of the area's development.

In Renmark, Olivewood Historic Homestead and Museum hosts the original home of Charles Chaffey, who with his brothers George and William established the Renmark irrigation colony, along with a vast range of memorabilia and agricultural equipment important to the town's history.

The Hotel Renmark museum also contains photographs, memorabilia, furnishings, table settings and other items that tell the unique story of the iconic building, while the Renmark Paringa Community Museum – located just over the, also historic, Paringa bridge – features an array of historic agricultural equipment and displays.

The Loxton Historical Village provides a true step back in time into how Riverland pioneers lived and worked, with more than 45 fully furnished buildings, and can be visited along with The Pines Historic House and Garden.

Visitors to Barmera can view the Loveday Internment Camp display, located in the Barmera Visitor Information Centre, and the Waikerie and District's Machine Preservation Society's museum historical farming exhibits, and the Morgan Museum, also cannot be missed.

A journey along the Murray River in itself offers a window into history, with a number of locks and weirs that have been used since the 1920s, plus ferries at Cadell, Lyrup, Morgan and Waikerie that have operated for more than a century.

Six locks are located in the region, beginning with Lock 1 at Blanchetown, and Lock 6 at Murtho. Information for visitors is available at Locks 1 to 5, with barbeque and picnic facilities available at Locks 2, 4, and 5. Visitors can also see the river barge 'The Bunyip', previously used to transport goods up and down the river, at Lock 5 at Paringa.

WAR TIME

A region steeped in connections to Australia's military history, the Riverland has many attractions that memorialise the sacrifices given by locals who have served.

Anzac Day and Remembrance Day commemorations are always major annual events, and draw large crowds to gather at local memorial sites.

The Renmark War Memorial includes a Cross of Sacrifice, and is located adjacent to The Soldiers Memorial Institute, which features honour rolls listing the names of local WWI soldiers.

Berri's military history is showcased through the Berri War Memorial, and Riverland Vietnam Veterans & Post WWII Memorial, which are just a short trip away from the Barmera Garden of Memory.

Commemorations in Loxton are held at the town's Soldiers Memorial Rotunda, while the town also houses a War Memorial featuring a stone cross.

In Waikerie, learn from storyboards depicting early irrigation at Federation Park, or see the decommissioned Worthington steam engine at Pioneer Park. The Waikerie Soldiers Memorial Oval was constructed in 1946 by returning servicemen from World War II and was dedicated to the men from Waikerie that sacrificed their lives in that conflict.

Today the oval is still the home ground of the Waikerie Football Club, known as the Magpies.

The Waikerie RSL sub-branch is the perfect place to honour the men and women who served Australia in times of conflict. Featuring a museum, honour rolls, bar, and regular bingo nights, the RSL provides a welcoming and relaxing experience for members, guests, and visitors.

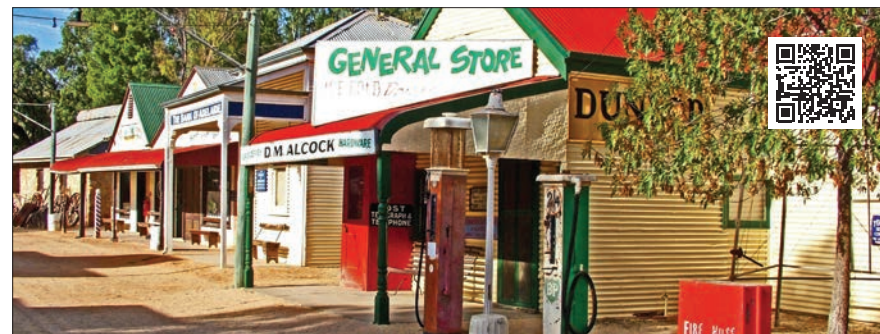

BARMERA, COBDOGLA, OVERLAND CORNER, AND LOVEDAY

Well-known for its tourism highlights, the humble town of Barmera is a worthwhile place to visit, both as a local and a visitor to the region.

Renowned for being home to the picturesque Lake Bonney, Barmera is also known for its rich wartime history, popular markets and country music attractions. It's well worth exploring the surrounding towns of Cobdogla, Overland Corner, and Loveday, which are all located within an easy drive of the main town.

LAKE BONNEY

Lake Bonney has been a popular destination for many years, with the large body of water making for spectacular views and incredible photo opportunities. Barmera is even named after the Aboriginal word for lake: Barmeedjie. The Lake's surrounding walking trails, exercise equipment and picnic spots are also great activity options.

OVERLAND CORNER

Another destination worth visiting is Overland Corner. Visitors can explore Herons Bend Reserve, or enjoy a historic tour at Overland Corner Hotel, which is also a perfect spot for a drink and a feed.

HISTORY, MUSEUMS AND GALLERIES

Barmera showcases a rich collection in wartime history, country music, and local artistic talent through the Loveday Internment Collection, Rocky's Hall of Fame and Pioneer Museum, and Bonney Theatre Art Gallery.

EVENTS

Throughout the year you will find various events inviting scores of people to see the town in a different light, including the Barmera Markets, SA Carp Frenzy, SA Sheep Dog Trials, and the Riverland Field Days.

RIVERLAND WEST, CADELL, MORGAN, AND BLANCHETOWN

If you're looking for an escape off the beaten track, you can't go past a tour of the Riverland West area. Cadell, Morgan and Blanchetown all played significant roles in the history and development of the Riverland, and offer a unique perspective of the region.

This part of the Riverland features the most northern point of the Murray River before heading south towards the Murray Mouth.

PORT OF MORGAN'S RIVERFRONT PRECINCT

Morgan is home to a picturesque river front with plenty to see and do. It's the perfect spot for a picnic with family or a lazy afternoon. A must see for families is the Morgan Rail to River Playground with free barbeque facilities and an amazing paddle steamer for the children to enjoy.

PADDLE STEAMER CANALLY, MORGAN WHARF

PS Canally is a side wheel paddle steamer that was originally launched in 1907. Local group of volunteers work tirelessly to restore this beautiful and historic vessel. If paddle steamers tickle your fancy then this one is well worth a look.

LANDSEER MUSEUM, MORGAN

Step back in time and visit the Landseers Museum, you'll find a collection of artefacts and mementos from this era, telling the story of local rail and river trade history. Come see the new 'Windows of Time' mural consisting of five panels of magnificent artwork done by three local ladies. Each panel tells 30 years of Morgan's history.

CADELL'S GRAEME CLAXTON RESERVE

Get back into nature by visiting this river-side reserve. With beautiful river views and a fantastic location for camping, this spot is well and truly a hidden gem for nature lovers. While you're there pop over and enjoy Cadell's Malcolm Moss walking trail – located left of Graeme Claxton Reserve. A must see for those that like the outdoors and enjoy the beautiful bird life.

LOCK 1 AT BLANCHETOWN

Lock 1 has been assisting river travel since 1922. It was the first of the series of locks and weirs that provided year-round navigability for river boats below the junction of the Murray and Darling rivers.

OLD WHARF SOUVENIR AND CRAFT SHOP

Located on the Morgan riverfront near the Station Masters House, this shop was the old ticket office for the trains. It has since been converted into a souvenir and gift shop, showcasing local produce and homemade goods from members of the community.

LOXTON, MOOROOK, AND KINGSTON ON MURRAY

Boasting a rich pioneering history, Loxton is a charming, vibrant town renowned for its friendly and community-minded atmosphere. Loxton's main street, East Terrace, is a bustling strip, with plenty of unique shopfronts to explore. Surrounding towns include Moorook and Kingston on Murray, with both towns boasting plenty of attractions to see, including the Moorook to Kingston on Murray walking trail connecting the two towns, the Moorook Riverfront Reserve and the picturesque Loch Luna Game Reserve, respectively.

LOXTON HISTORICAL VILLAGE

From East Terrace it is a short stroll to the Loxton Historical Village. The region's open-air museum features more than 45 buildings, plus numerous farming equipment displays, giving visitors a taste of what life was like for the region's pioneers. The Loxton Historical Village is featured in the Loxton History Tour podcast, which can be accessed via the Storytowns App.

THE PINES HISTORIC HOUSE AND GARDEN

This historic home, its contents and the extensive gardens were bequeathed to the people of Loxton by the late Ella Kingdon.

LOXTON PIONEER PLAYGROUND

For the young and young-at-heart, a stop off at the Loxton Pioneer Playground is a must do. An ideal place for a picnic or barbeque under one of the sheltered seating areas, the playground features a large climbing structure, double flying fox, electronic NEOS game, and a bike/scooter track among many other things.

'HEAVEN' CLIFFTOP LOOKOUT

The 'Heaven' clifftop lookout – as it is affectionately referred to by locals – provides a vantage point above Habel's Bend to look out across the river to Katarapko Island, part of the Murray River National Park. Climb the 'stairway to Heaven' from the base of the cliff at Habel's Bend. The lookout also features seating and shade shelters, so sit back, relax and enjoy the view.

BANROCK STATION

While in the area you can also wander Banrock Station's boardwalks and trails that weave through the Ramsar listed wetland, which is home to more than 17,000 species of native plants, animals and birds.

WAIKERIE

The scenic town of Waikerie, just 180kms from Adelaide, offers a great array of experiences for every visitor. A true reflection of the local community and environment, Waikerie boasts a charming shopping precinct filled with locally owned businesses offering unique products. Enjoy a variety of dining options, from the local hotel and club to bakeries and cafes, where you can sample local crafts and edible treasures. Whether you're browsing the shops or indulging in the region's culinary delights, Waikerie has something special for every traveller.

GLUEPOT RESERVE

Just 64km north of Waikerie is Gluepot Reserve, dedicated to the conservation of native bird species. Gluepot houses approximately 190 species of birds, 50 species of reptiles and 11 species of bats. Facilities for human visitors include a guest centre, campgrounds, bird hides, driving, walking and cycling trails.

WAIKERIE RIVERFRONT

With more than a kilometre of river front access there's plenty of shady trees, extensive grassed areas including an amphitheatre, picnic shelters, free barbeques, boat ramp, walking paths, toilets and ample parking. This is an excellent location for outdoor gatherings at any time of year with substantial river access for boating, fishing and swimming. The young (and young at heart) will have plenty to do with an undercover playground, pump track, sensory track and outdoor ping pong table.

CLIFFTOP WALK AND SILO ART

Stretching eastward from the Waikerie Riverfront, the Rotary Clifftop Walk offers spectacular views as you pass through the pumping station grounds, climb the lookout tower, and wind along the scenic clifftop. Perfect for photographers and nature lovers, this walk provides multiple vantage points to capture stunning views. A contemplation seat – generously donated by Silent Ripples – invites you to pause and take in the scenery. Along the way, you'll discover a mini silo painted by local artist Jarrod Loxton, as well as an array of metal sculptures in various shapes and sizes. These unique pieces, scattered throughout the area, are perfect for both adults and children to enjoy. A highlight of the walk is the "Healthy River, Healthy Community" silo art, featuring a giant yabby, regent parrot, and semi-abstract river scenes. The silo garden, with its native plants and metal sculptures – including the iconic 'Murray' – offers a fantastic backdrop for photos with the beautifully painted silos.

WAIKERIE ART TRAIL

Waikerie showcases a diverse range of public art and galleries. Numerous buildings display creative, vibrant images of art significant to the area and two galleries are available to view local works of art. Drop into the Waikerie Library & Visitor Centre to pick up a trail map.

CITY TO RIVER

Whatever direction you are travelling from, all corners of the region offer unique and unforgettable food, wine, history and experiences. Get into gear with our suggested driving routes, enjoying scenery fit for a postcard along the way.

ADELAIDE – WAIKERIE

It doesn't take long to reach the gateway of the Riverland, travelling 141km from Adelaide to Blanchetown. A quick detour into the town for a takeaway coffee from the heritage-listed Blanchetown Hotel and get your first glimpse at the mighty Murray while viewing Lock 1.

Back on the road for a further 42km to Waikerie and head straight to Rain Moth Gallery to take in the local and South Australian arts and crafts on show. Admire artworks inspired by the local landscapes or purchase a piece of the Riverland to take home. While in town, grab your picnic basket and stock up on grazing treats from Illalangi Gourmet Foods. Find a range of bulk foods, gourmet hampers, condiments, artisan goods and more. Their new store is situated in the Waikerie Silo carpark, conveniently next to the Waikerie Rotary Cliff Top Walk.

After some sightseeing, it's time for lunch at the historic Overland Corner Hotel, situated 40 minutes down the road in Overland Corner. Delicious food and local Woolshed Brewery drinks are on offer seven-days a week. The 'OC' was built in 1859 to cater for drovers and remains as one of the oldest standing structures in the state. Capture the feel of a relaxed drinking hole, with huge meal options.

Waikerie offers a range of accommodation from the Echo Holiday Parks, or for large groups check out River Rest, or a more private, romantic stay at Wigley Retreat. Heading home, we recommend stopping in at the award-winning Burk Salter Wines to stock up on their boutique collection. Beautiful vineyard views and wetland tours are also on offer.

This short trip allows for the perfect mix of sights, local produce and artistry, finished off with delicious food and wines.

MILDURA – RENMARK

There is no excuse not to make the quick trip over from Mildura, being only 140km means sleeping in does not need to be sacrificed. Arriving at your first destination, the picturesque Riverland Wine Centre gives you the opportunity to gaze over their stunning wetland views while sipping on a coffee or sampling a few wines to enjoy later. Their extensive range and knowledge of the local wine region is almost as impressive as their cliff-side location. Make sure to grab a few local goodies to take back on your travels.

Continuing on, travel the short distance to Paringa where the kids can enjoy the new nature play park and parents can browse the variety at Cammie's Antiques or the Renmark Paringa Community Museum, two great places for collectors or the curious at heart. Heading up Murtho Road towards Wilkadene Woolshed Brewery will take around a 10-minute drive past orchards and vineyards. Get your hands on a tasting flight of their brews made on site with local influence throughout - favourites include their Amazon Ale and Firehouse Stout. A much-loved spot for all locals alike, the Woolshed Brewery is both unique and fun, being one of the best spots to enjoy a 'cold one' overlooking the Murray River on their extensive deck and lawn areas.

The journey is far from done as you travel across the iconic Paringa Bridge and into the town of Renmark. Boasting river-front dining at the Renmark Club, refined spirits at 23rd Street Distillery, or jump in the boat for some fast-paced water sports, you will not get bored. Renmark offers abundant history across all categories including cruising on the PS Industry or a taste of the region's most decorated brew, St Agnes brandy, at Angove Family Winemaker's cellar door.

MURRAY BRIDGE – LOXTON

Travelling along the Karoonda Highway through the Mallee scrublands and vast wheat fields you will be met with vibrant yet sentimental silo art. Situated at Karoonda, and a quick off-route visit to Lameroo provides a chance to capture the iconic artworks depicting the local farm life heartaches, wildlife and landscapes.

One hour later, rolling into Loxton you will discover a charming, community-loving town overlooking the glistening Murray River. Along their main street, East Terrace, is endless dining options. Enjoy a slice from the famed Loxton Pizza Bar or make it fancier at the newly renovated Loxton Hotel. Taking a stroll down East Terrace, you will find numerous locally owned stores to satisfy the retail junkies.

Loxton is renowned for its strong sense of community and well-preserved heritage by years of dedication from families and volunteers alike. The Loxton Historical Village is a major drawcard for the whole family, along with a visit to The Pines Historic House and Garden to experience the customs of yesteryear.

Now that the history lesson is over, it's time to experience the ever-lasting produce on offer. Whistling Kite Biodynamic Wines, approximately a 15-minute drive from Loxton in New Residence, is an award-winning organic take on Riverland wine. Owners Pam and Tony pride themselves on having a minimal-impact approach, benefitting their beautiful surrounds of vineyards, birdlife, insects and wildlife.

Loxton is the perfect mix for both adults and children, boasting mountain bike and pump tracks, numerous outdoor play areas, or just settling into the sands of one of their sparkling sandbars with rod in hand.

TRAVELLER'S GUIDE

PATIENCE ON THE ROAD

Excitement levels are always high when travelling to the Riverland, but that doesn't mean you have to rush to arrive at your destination. Sticking to the speed limits on the highway and inside towns means your hip pocket won't be getting hit for the wrong reasons, and ensures your friends and family will be able to enjoy the Riverland and return home safely.

WATER SAFETY

Everyone loves getting out on the river, but as recent statistics show, having safety in mind is key when in, or around, the water. If you're having fun in a boat, wearing a life jacket at all times is a must, as well as avoiding any alcohol when operating a vessel. If swimming, keep an eye on river flows and watch out for submerged objects underwater, and holes at sandbars.

KEEP THE CARP

Efforts are ongoing within the region to decrease the number of invasive European carp in the Murray River and local waterways. It is imperative that once carp are caught, they are not returned to the water, in order to give the numbers of our native fish a chance to recover. For a full list of fishing regulations visit (pir.sa.gov.au) before heading out.

DON'T BE THE PEST

Local vineyards and orchards are among the Riverland's most valuable assets, but are vulnerable to outbreaks of pests that can be transferred from footwear. When taking a tour of a vineyard, please follow all instructions given by the guide and where asked, avoid walking among grape vines.

FIRE ALWAYS A RISK

The Riverland's fire season generally runs for 15 November to 15 April, when strict conditions surround the lighting of fires. No fires, including campfires, can be lit on Total Fire Ban days, and in summer it is always crucial to know the risks and have a safety plan. Download the CFS app, visit its Facebook page, or contact the Bushfire Information Hotline on 1300 362 361 for further information.

EASY TO GET AROUND

Planning a big day, or night, at one of the Riverland's wineries, clubs, or hotels? Prevent any road risks by leaving the keys at home and organising transport through the local taxi service. Larger groups can organise a bus in advance, or take advantage of the community buses offered by some venues.

TIME TO RECHARGE

Driving an electric vehicle? Don't think a visit to the Riverland will be filled with range anxiety, as major Riverland towns now all boast a number of charging stations.

NEED A REPAIR?

While we do our best to plan holidays, sometimes a flat tyre or engine trouble come out of nowhere. Fortunately any car or caravan repairs can quickly and professionally be taken care of inside the region, so you can get back to enjoying the Riverland.

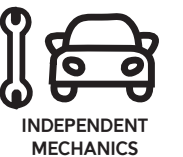
